

Refuse Set Out Requirements

Carts & Collection:

- ▶ Please set out all carts, bags, and buckets no later than 6:00 a.m. day of collection or no earlier than night before collection.
- ▶ Please do not overfill garbage or yard waste carts. Lids must be able to fully close.
- ▶ Please call our office before pickup day when you have extra items so that we may alert the driver and insure pickup. There are fees for extra pick-ups, which vary depending on quantity and size.

Missed pick-up:

If your collection at your residence has been missed please call our office at 456-2601. If after business hours you may leave a message.

Holiday pick-up:

Collection does not occur on Christmas or New Year's Day. If collection day should fall onto one of these holidays, collection will be one day later. For example, if the holiday falls on a Thursday, Thursday collection would occur on Friday and Friday's collection would occur on Saturday.

Yard Waste Collection

Please call our office to have a pick-up schedule sent to you for yard waste collection if you live in an area receiving every other week service.

Automated service customers ONLY

Carts must be placed on the street no later than 6am day of collection or no earlier than the day before collection. Keep all carts at least 3 feet from anything that may block the collection truck's automated arm.

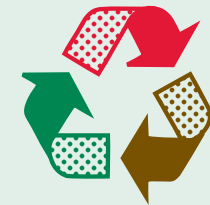

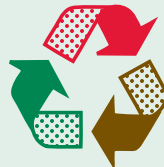
